Project Title

Prediction of Dengue with Climate Change over Delhi and Rajkot: A statistical analysis and development of warning system

About the project

In view of major dengue outbreaks across India over recent years, having close connection with the environment, this study will build an early warning system of Dengue prediction for the city of Delhi and Rajkot based on its association with local climate factors including temperature, precipitation and relative humidity. Based on the statistical relationship between Dengue sensitive climate parameters and its incidences for present, future scenarios of Dengue outbreak will be built which will be an important mitigation measure. The collective methodologies include securing Dengue incidence data, selection of climate variables influencing Dengue inception, adaptation of suitable statistical method to establish the relation, an analysis of inter annual as well as seasonal climate variability and application of GIS tool to prepare the Dengue vulnerable zones in Delhi and Rajkot.

Responsibilities

Intern will be engaged to support following activities/outputs -

- Mapping incidences of Dengue in city of Rakjot and Delhi based on historic data and primary surveys.
- Mapping Dengue vulnerable zones in Delhi and Rajkot using GIS tools.
- Interns will collect required dengue data collection from Government hospitals, municipal bodies, health centers, meteorology both in Delhi and Gujarat
- Analyse dependence of climate variables such as temperature, precipitation and relative humidity on Dengue spread in Delhi and Rajkot.
- Identify and assess the measures/best practices on early warning systems for Dengue control.
- Interns have to submit project report as per the requirements of the project
